1. Privacy and Cookie Policy

Your Privacy

We're committed to protecting your information. We offer our services freely for you to enjoy in comfort knowing we do everything possible to protect your data whilst using this site. However, for you to use this application we do require some information from you which could be accessed by the public. Rest assured however, this information could by no means be used to identify you or a member of your family.

To help you understand what information we might capture read on.

Cookies

MOD.uk puts small files (known as 'cookies') onto your computer to collect information about how you browse the site.

Cookies are used to:

- measure how you use the website so it can be updated and improved based on your needs
- remember the notifications you've seen so that we don't show them to you again

MOD.UK cookies aren't used to identify you personally.

You'll normally see a message on the site before we store a cookie on your computer.

Measuring website usage (Google Analytics)

We use Google Analytics software to collect information about how you use MOD.UK. We do this to help make sure the site is meeting the needs of its users and to help us make improvements.

Google Analytics stores information about:

- the pages you visit on mod.uk
- how long you spend on each mod.uk page□
- how you got to the site □
- what you click on while you're visiting the site

We don't collect or store your personal information (eg your name or address) so this information can't be used to identify who you are.

We don't allow Google to use or share our analytics data.

Google Analytics sets the following cookies:
